

If the need arises and your child requires services, the Home / Hospital program looks forward to working with you and your child's school.

A child or youth shall be provided Home / Hospital instruction if the condition of the child or youth prevents or renders inadvisable attendance at school as verified by a signed statement in accordance with KRS 159.030 (2) [704 KAR 7:120, Section 2 (1)]

Home / Hospital Program
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The Home / Hospital program is a service to students who are unable to attend school for five consecutive days or longer due to medical reasons. The Home / Hospital teacher serves as a liaison between participating students and their classroom teachers. Assignments are gathered and presented to students at two visits each week with one hour of instruction each visit.

The Home / Hospital program is to be used on a limited basis until the child has been released to go back to school.

Who is Eligible?

There are many reasons why a student might be eligible for Home / Hospital. Some of these reasons include:

- * surgery
- * cancer
- * orthopedic issues
- * postpartum
- * other medical conditions



How to apply...

To be eligible for Home / Hospital educational services, an application must be submitted which includes a medical statement with specific diagnosis, completed and signed by a licensed medical professional. The application can be obtained through the child's school, Bullitt County Public Schools website (www.bullittschools.org) or calling the Board of Education. A new Home / Hospital application will need to be submitted every six months and at the beginning of each school year because the application will not carry over from the year before.



Pending Approval

As your child's application is being reviewed, he/she must continue to be in regular attendance until you have been contacted by the Home / Hospital Coordinator. If your child is unable to attend, please provide doctor notes to the school.

Parents of students who are approved for services will be contacted by the Home / Hospital teacher to set up visits.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where do I obtain a Home / Hospital application?

You can obtain a Home/ Hospital application at your child's school, the Board of Education or the Bullitt County Public Schools website (www.bullittschools.org).

2. If the child is under 18 years of age does there have to be an adult present?

Yes, if the child who is receiving services is under 18 there must be an adult present during the entire Home/ Hospital lesson.

3. Can my child still participate in after school activities (sports/ job) while on the home / hospital program?

No. Students who are receiving services cannot participate in after school activities like football, basketball and they can not work a job. If they are too ill to attend school they are to ill for other activities (KAR 7:120,Section 2 (6)).
